Since 2013 Customs Policy of Russia in the Far East is a participant of the Russian Science Citation Index project (RSCI) and indexed in the Scientific Electronic Library database (elibrary.ru).

The journal Customs Policy of Russia in the Far East is a peer-reviewed journal. The editorial

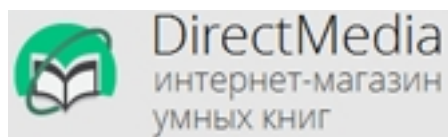
